PUBLIC NOTICE:

OUTDOOR WATERING RESTRICTION

The Town of Sedgewick is implementing a restriction on all outdoor watering immediately to ensure an adequate water supply and reserves for all necessary health and life services, including fire services. The following outdoor watering schedule will be in force:

NO OUTDOOR WATERING PERMITTED MONDAYS

Odd-numbered houses may water odd-numbered dates

Even-numbered houses may water even-numbered dates

Example - if your address is 4818 - 47 Street - you would water on the 2,4,6,8 and so on. Odd numbered houses would water on the 1,3,5,7.....

This ban is in effect until further notice.

Please take care to ensure that when you do water, you set your sprinklers so that the water does not run down the street. Please be considerate and remember that this ban is to preserve the water supply of the town during this dry time.
