Dog Bylaw # 464

Every dog over the age of three months in the Town of Sedgewick shall be licensed yearly, **before the 31st day of January.** Every owner who after the 31st day of January in any calendar year acquires a dog or who has a dog and lives in Sedgewick has fourteen (14) days to license his or her dog.

You will need to bring veterinary documentation to support your licensing if not already on file with the Town.

Monthly Tax Payment - Bylaw #459-08

- ★ Taxpayers may pay taxes on a **monthly basis** subject to the following conditions:
- ★ a) The Taxpayer must notify the Town Office of their desire to be on the monthly payment plan and provide the first payment within the month of January.
- ★ b) For the first five months of the current year the taxpayer shall pay a monthly payment equivalent to one twelfth of the tax based on previous year's tax notice.
- ★ c) For the last seven months of the year the taxpayer shall make seven monthly payments equivalent to the balance of the tax levy for the current year.
- ★ **All payments are due in the Town Bank account before the last banking day of each month.**
- ★ If you wish to be included on this Tax payment program **YOU MUST** contact the office on or before **January 31st** and have **provided the first month payment on your taxes.**

Civic Addressing Bylaw #468

No person shall display, or permit the displaying of any Address Number on a property other than the number assigned by the Town.

Every property within the Town, shall be designated an **Address Number by the Town.**

The owner of a property shall display the Address Number assigned to the property, at all times in a location plainly visible from the roadway to which the property is addressed.

If the property has a **rear garage, or shed, or fence within (49.2 feet or 15 meters) of the back lane, a rear address must also be displayed.** The rear address number shall meet the same display requirements as the front address number.

The Address Number in rural areas shall be affixed in a conspicuous place, either: **a)** on a sign adjacent to the driveway at property line; or **b)** on the paper delivery box.

The **Address Number is required to be displayed on contrasting background.**

The minimum size of the characters shall be as follows:

Distance of Building Setback from Adjacent Curb Line
0 - 15 m (0 - 49.2 ft.) number size - 10 cm (4 inches)
15 - 20 m (49.2 - 65.6 ft.) number size - 15 cm (6 inches)
Greater than 20 m (65.6 ft.) number size - 20 cm (8 inches)
 Address Number signs shall have a surface area of no more than 0.3 square meters (3.30 square feet). **b)** For multi-dwellings, one Address Number sign not exceeding 1 square meter (10.76 square Feet) in area shall be allowed on each property.

The owner of a parcel of land which is a **construction site**, and for which a structure is being erected shall ensure that a temporary Address Number is displayed at all times in a conspicuous manner so as to be plainly visible from the adjacent roadway or lane, as the case may be. This number must be displayed at least two months prior to completion of construction.

Penalties under the Bylaw will be enforced starting January 2011.

Please make sure to keep your gates, sidewalks and meters (Gas & Water) clear of snow to help keep our meter readers safe on the job.

Remember that your sidewalks need to be cleared off within 48 hours after a snow fall.

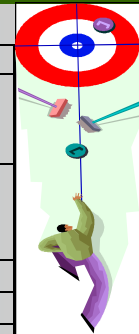

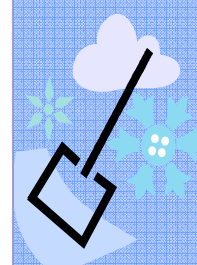
