WATERING RESTRICTION BYLAW #473

The Town of Sedgewick has implemented a restriction on all outdoor watering to ensure an adequate water supply and reserves for all necessary health and life services, including fire services.

The following outdoor watering schedule will be in force from **June 1st to October 1st.**

NO OUTDOOR WATERING PERMITTED MONDAYS

No Outdoor Watering between the hours of **9 am and 6 pm**

Odd-numbered houses can water on Wednesday, Friday and Sunday ie (4809 – 48 Street)

Even-numbered houses can water on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday ie (4818 – 48 Street)

Property Tax and Assessment Notices were sent out early on **May 25, 2011** due to concerns about a possible postal strike. The Assessment Roll is open for inspection and any appeal of assessment must be filed using the government-regulated Assessment Review Board Complaint Form by **July 30, 2011.** Forms available at Town office and on the Town or Municipal Affairs websites. There is a **\$50.00 residential assessment appeal fee** for each residential property being appealed and a **\$650.00 commercial assessment appeal fee** for any commercial or residential dwelling sites with 4 or more units. Please note that appeals can only be made on the assessment; taxes cannot be appealed. Complaints **MUST** relate only to the assessment on your property.

Please remember that Taxes are due JULY 29, 2011

Traffic Bylaw #440

9.3 No person shall park any manner of trailer on a highway unless the trailer is attached to a vehicle by which it may be properly drawn, and when so attached the trailer shall be part of the vehicle and subject to any regulations pertaining to the vehicle.

9.4 No person shall, without permission of the person owning, occupying or controlling a private property in a residential area, park a recreational vehicle on a highway other than on that portion of the highway immediately adjoining property owned, occupied or otherwise controlled by that person.

9.5 No vehicle shall be parked on a highway for more than twenty four (24) continuous hours, owners of vehicles parked on a highway adjoining their personal property.

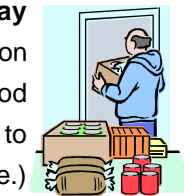
9.6 Except as permitted in Section 9.4, any vehicle parked for more than seventy-two (72) hours shall be considered abandoned.
