

Boulevard Maintenance Policy
Council wishes to ensure that boulevards, back alleys and side yard perimeters and areas around fire hydrants are maintained in a condition that:

- Maximizes public safety
- allows response to emergencies by Fire, Ambulance and Police Services

Therefore the Town of Sedgewick will provide direction for the maintenance of these areas to achieve these objectives.
To set procedures for the maintenance and upkeep of boulevards, back alley and side yard perimeters and areas around fire hydrants.
Maintenance of boulevards, back alley and side-yard perimeters and access to fire hydrants are the responsibility of the **adjoining property owner**.

The **property owner** is responsible for:

- landscaping and weed control of the adjoining boulevard and the back alley and side-yard perimeters
- snow removal around fire hydrants on an adjoining boulevard.

Severe Winter Storm Tips

- **Stay indoors**
- **Listen for radio and TV broadcasts regarding the storm and any emergency information. Have a battery-operated radio - electricity may go out.**
- **Do not travel unless it is urgent.**
- **Electricity may go out - have an alternate, safe way of heating your home, cooking your meals and lighting your home. Remember if you use an alternative source of heat, you must make sure it is properly ventilated, and it does not use up the oxygen in your home.**
- **Telephone lines may go down so listen to your battery-operated radio for any important information.**



The **Town of Sedgewick** will be responsible for:

- maintenance and repair of sidewalks on the boulevard
- maintenance and repair of fire hydrants
- **To help prevent water pipes from freezing, keep cabinet doors open to allow warm air to circulate around pipes (particularly in the kitchen and bathroom)**
- **Keeping a slow trickle of water flowing through faucets connected to pipes that run through an unheated or unprotected space. Or drain the water system, especially if your house will be unoccupied during the winter months.**

If you must go outdoors, prepare yourself against the cold and find shelter as soon as possible.
