

**Town of Sedgewick
BY-LAW NO. 444**

**A BYLAW TO CREATE THE POSITION OF ASSESSOR
FOR THE TOWN OF SEDGEWICK**

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, Revised statutes of Alberta 2000, Ch. M-26, with amendments in force as of January 1, 2003, Section 208 (1) (m) which decrees that the Chief Administrative Officer must ensure that assessments and assessment rolls for the municipality are prepared, and

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 209, the Chief Administrative Officer may delegate any of his/her duties to a Designated Officer of the municipality, and furthermore that

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 210 (1), a Council may by bylaw establish one or more positions to carry out the powers, duties or functions of a designated officer under the authority of this bylaw,

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Sedgewick, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That the position of Assessor is hereby established as a Designated Officer of the Town of Sedgewick.
2. The Assessor will be appointed by resolution of Council.
3. Pursuant to the MGA, Section 210 (4), the Assessor is subject to the supervision of and accountable to the Chief Administrative Officer.
4. The appointment of the Assessor may be revoked by Council under the provisions of the MGA, Section 211.
5. Powers, duties and functions of the Assessor will be as prescribed by the MGA in Sections 284 to Section 304 inclusive, excepting thereout Section 292 (Assessment for linear property).
6. Title: that this Bylaw may be known and cited as the "Assessor Bylaw."

This bylaw shall come into force and take effect immediately upon signing.

Read a first time this 19th day of October 2006.

Read a second time this 19th day of October 2006.

Read a third time and by unanimous consent of all Councillors present, passed into law on this 19th day of October 2006.
